

Simple present questions I/you/we/you/they

Questions

Do	I you we you they	play tennis?
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Short answers

Yes, I/you/we/you/they **do**.

No, I/you/we/you/they **don't**.

Use **do** with the simple present to form questions.

Affirmative form → Question form
They live in Boston. → *Do they live in Boston?* ✓
They live in Boston. → *They live in Boston?* ✗

Short answers

Yes, they **do**. ✓

No, they **don't**. ✓

Yes, they **live**. ✗

No, they **don't live**. ✗
