

JOINING SENTENCES ☆ WRONG ORDER.

There are sixteen pieces on each side. Chess is a game for two people. “Checkmate” means that the king cannot move without being taken by another piece. The board and the pieces can be in any two contrasting colors. Pieces move in different ways. Computers sometimes beat human champions. Chess is played on a checkered board. Each side has one king, one queen, two knights, two bishops, two rooks, and eight pawns. The game ends when one of the kings is “checkmated.” Chess is a very old game which remains popular today.



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
