- **outdoor activities (n.):** activities; games or sports done/played in the open air (กิจกรรมกลางแจ้ง)
- **rock climbing (n.):** a sport of climbing up very steep rock surfaces such as the sides of mountains (การปีนเขา)
- **rappelling (n.):** climbing down a cliff or rock by sliding down a rope and touching the rock or cliff with your feet (การไต่เขาลงมา)
- **hiking (n.):** the activity of taking long walks in the mountains or country (การเดินเขา)
- **trekking (n.):** any long and difficult journey, especially on foot (การเดินป่า, การเที่ยวป่า)
- **scuba diving (n.):** the sport of swimming under water while breathing through a tube that is connected to a container of air on your back (การดำน้ำลึก)
- **birdwatching (n.):** a form of wildlife observation in which the observation of birds is a recreational activity (การดูนก)
- **kitesurfing (n.):** the activity of moving across water on a surfboard while holding a large kite which is attached to strong strings (การเล่นเซิร์ฟโดยใช้ว่าวหรือร่มและลมช่วยขับเคลื่อนบนผิวน้ำ)



- **skiing (n.):** the sport of moving down hill, across land in the snow, or on water wearing skis (การเล่นสกี)
- **whitewater rafting (n.):** the activity of floating in a raft along rivers where the current is very fast and rough (การล่องแก่ง, การล่องแพ)
- **suggestion (n.):** an idea, plan, or possibility that someone mentions, or act of mentioning it (การเสนอแนะ, ข้อเสนอนำเสนอ)
- **refuse (v.):** to say firmly that you will not do something that someone has asked you to do (ปฏิเสธ)
- **invitation (n.):** a written or spoken request to someone, inviting them to go somewhere or do something (การเชิญชวน, คำเชิญ)
- **laundry (n.):** the act of washing and ironing clothes (งานซักผ้า)
- **video arcade (n.):** a public place where there are a lot of video games that you play by putting money in the machines (สถานที่เล่นเกมตู้)
- **amusement park (n.):** an open area with swings, roundabouts, shooting galleries, etc. where one can amuse oneself (สวนสนุก)
- **stadium (n.):** a large sports ground surrounded by rows of seats and usually other buildings (สนามกีฬา)

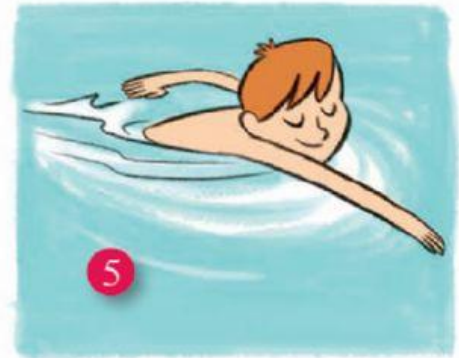
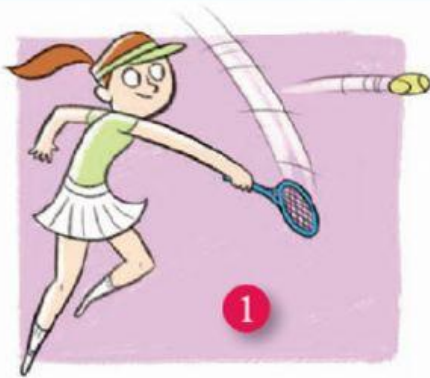
