3. Read the text about Vincent Van Gogh, and answer the questions:

Vincent Willem Van Gogh was born in Netherlands in 1853. He was a Dutch post-impressionist painter.

He had a difficult life because he had from mental illness. He never got married. He began to draw and paint seriously when he was 27, and he died when he was 37.

In a decade Vincent created 2.100 art works. At first Van Gogh painted poor people and used only dark colours. Later he moved to the south of France. He loved the sunlight there and his style of painting became colourful and exciting.

Unfortunately Van Gogh wasn't commercially successful, he only sold one painting before he died. He was often depressed. First, he cut off part of his ear, and then in 1890, he killed himself.
