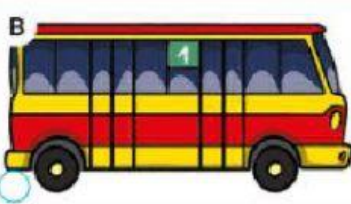

DO YOU KNOW YOUR COUNTRY'S NATIONAL ANIMAL(S)?

A New Zealand

The national animal – and at the same time the national bird of New Zealand – is the kiwi. It has a long beak, long feathers, strong legs and no tail. It cannot fly, but it is curious and smart. It prefers to be active at night. The kiwi is such a popular symbol of New Zealand that the country's inhabitants are often called "Kiwis".

B Australia

The official national symbol of Australia has got images of two animals native for the continent: the kangaroo and the emu, the largest bird living there. They were chosen for the coat of arms* because they represent a nation which moves forward, as neither of the animals is able to move backwards easily.

C The United States of America

Apart from the bald eagle which was recognised as the national animal in 1782, the USA has another one: the American bison. In 2016, it was declared to be "the historical symbol of the USA" by Barack Obama, the US president at the time. The bison is the largest animal living in the USA – it can weigh up to one ton. The bison is always on the move – it walks even when it eats. The bison became the symbol of this country because it is strong and fearless.
