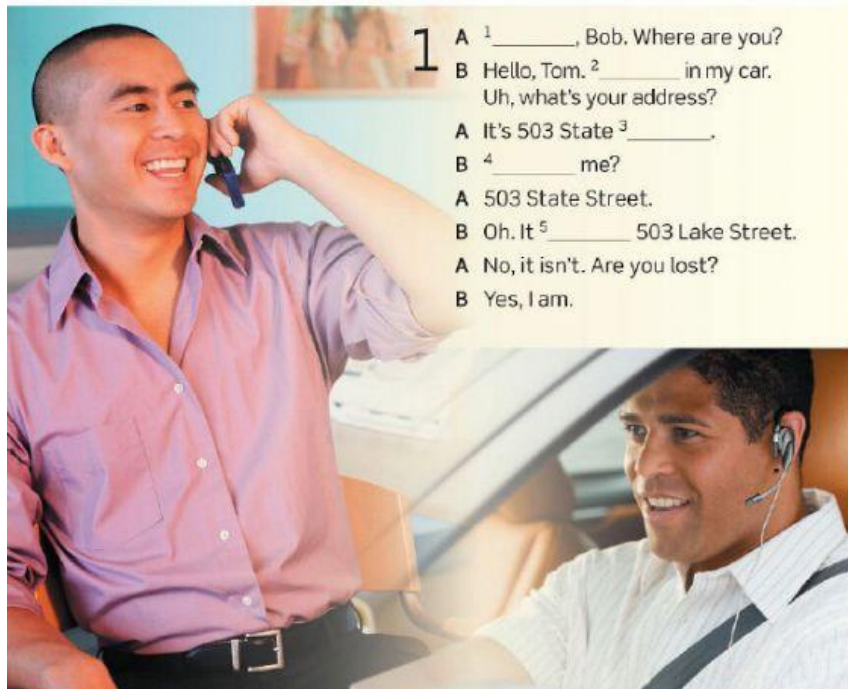

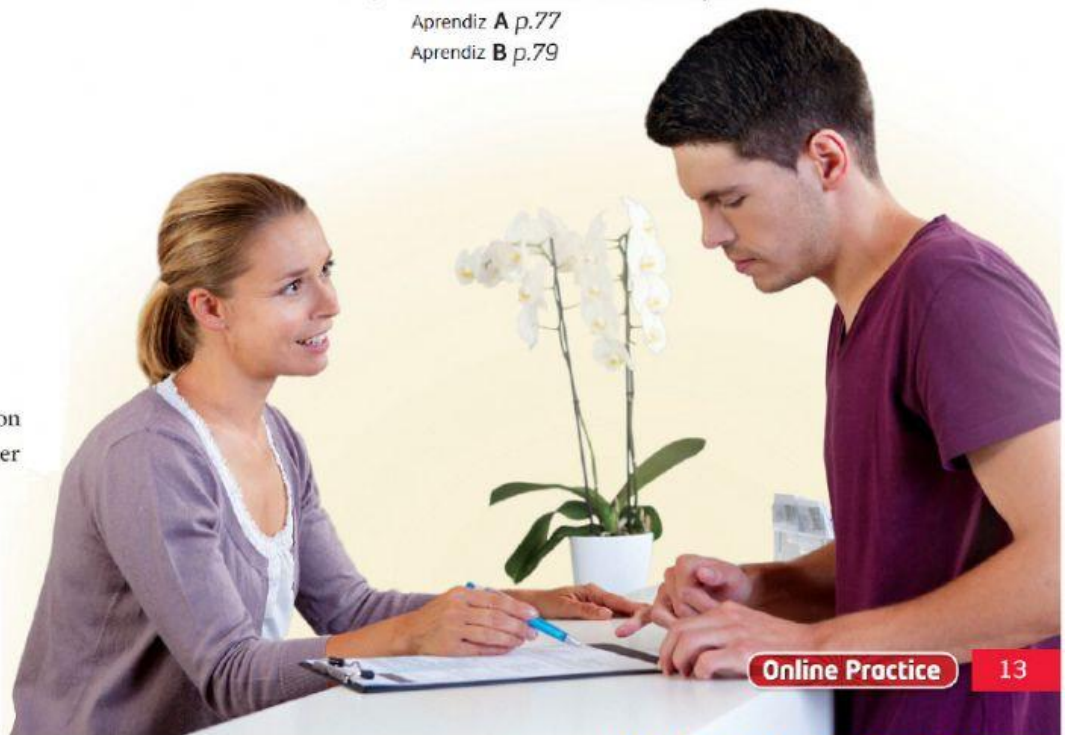

You can ask questions with What's, Where's, When's, and How's.

Ud. puede hacer preguntas con What's, Where's, When's, y How's.

What's her name? (= What is her name?)

Where's he from? (= Where is he from?)

How's your mother? (= How is your mother?)

Don't contract is in a question when the last word is a pronoun (he, she, it, etc.).

No contraiga la palabra is cuando la última palabra es un pronombre (he, she, it, etc.).

How old is she? NOT How old's she?

Where is he? NOT Where's he?

What is it? NOT What's it?
