Yuri orbited the Earth in a spacecraft named Vostok 1, which consisted of two parts: one for Yuri and the other for his supplies of oxygen and water. Vostok 1 circled the Earth in 108 minutes at 27,400 kilometers per hour. Yuri's return to Earth was controlled by a computer and he landed by parachute after being ejected from the spacecraft.
