

CONDITIONAL SENTENCES – TYPES 2 AND 3

EX 1 COMPLETE THE CONDITIONAL SENTENCES (TYPE 2) BY PUTTING THE VERBS INTO THE CORRECT FORM.

5. If I (not / have) a computer, I (borrow) one.

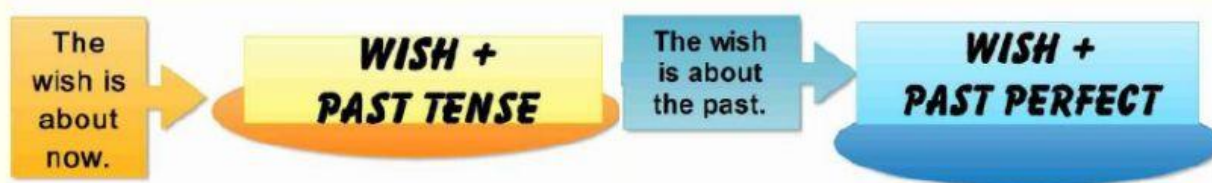
