At the bank

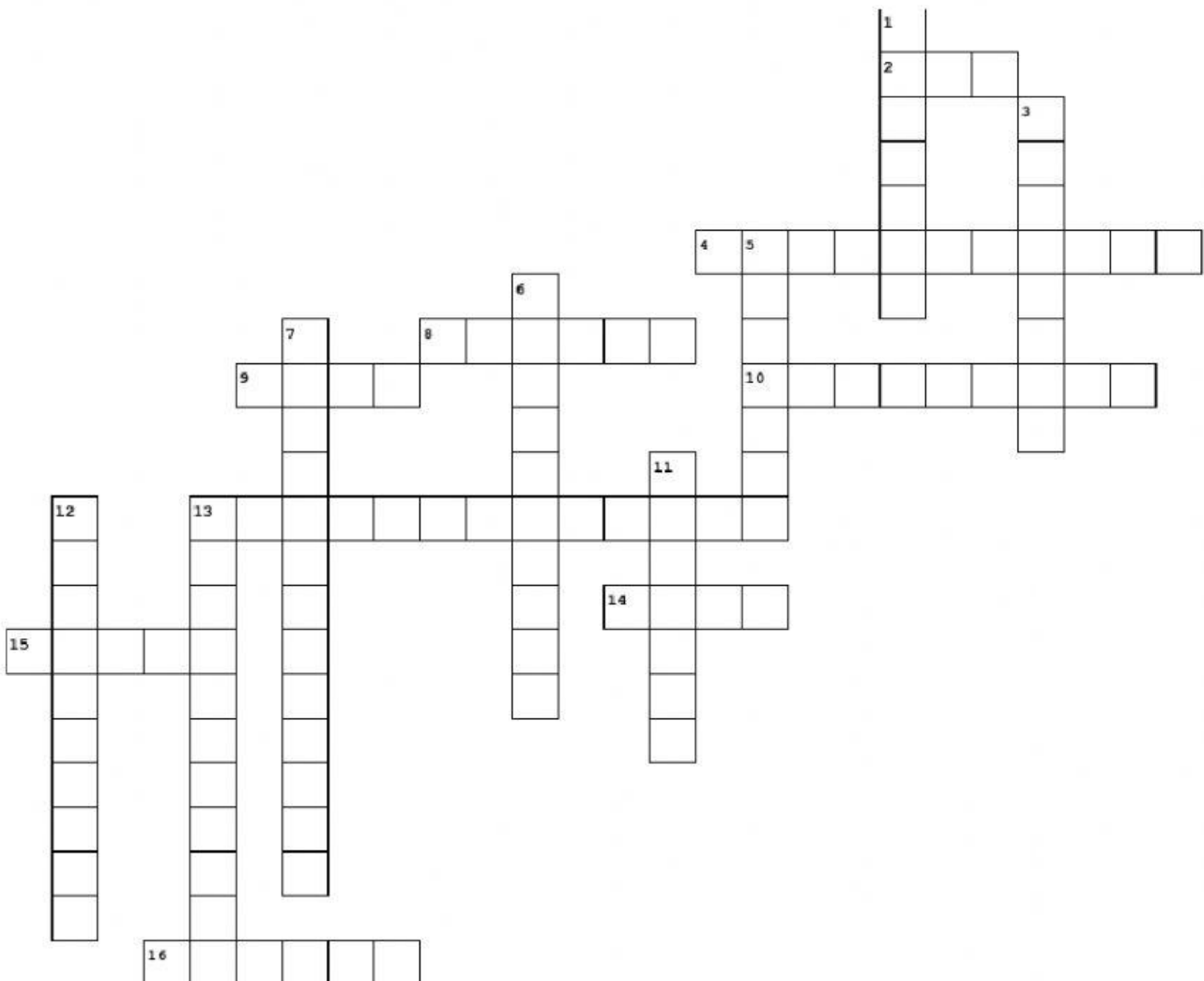
1. Answer the questions with your classmates and your teacher:

14. borrowed money that is received now but needs to be paid back, often monthly, with interest added
