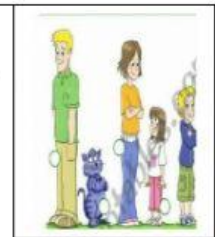

RULE 1 – Regular Verbs

Most of the verbs are regular. We just need to add "ing" at the end.

Example - read – read**ing**, walk – walk**ing**, jump – jump**ing**, fish – fish**ing**

RULE 2 – Magical 'E'

If a word ends in magic e, you need to drop the "e" before adding "ing".

Example - take – tak**ing**, bake – bak**ing**, bite – bit**ing**, skate – skat**ing**

RULE 3 – Ending CVC words

When a word with one syllable ends in **CVC** (consonant-vowel-consonant), then you need to double the last consonant before adding "ing". **But fix – fixing, mix-mixing**

Example - stop – stop**ping**, mop – mop**ping**, skip – skip**ping**, run – run**ning**

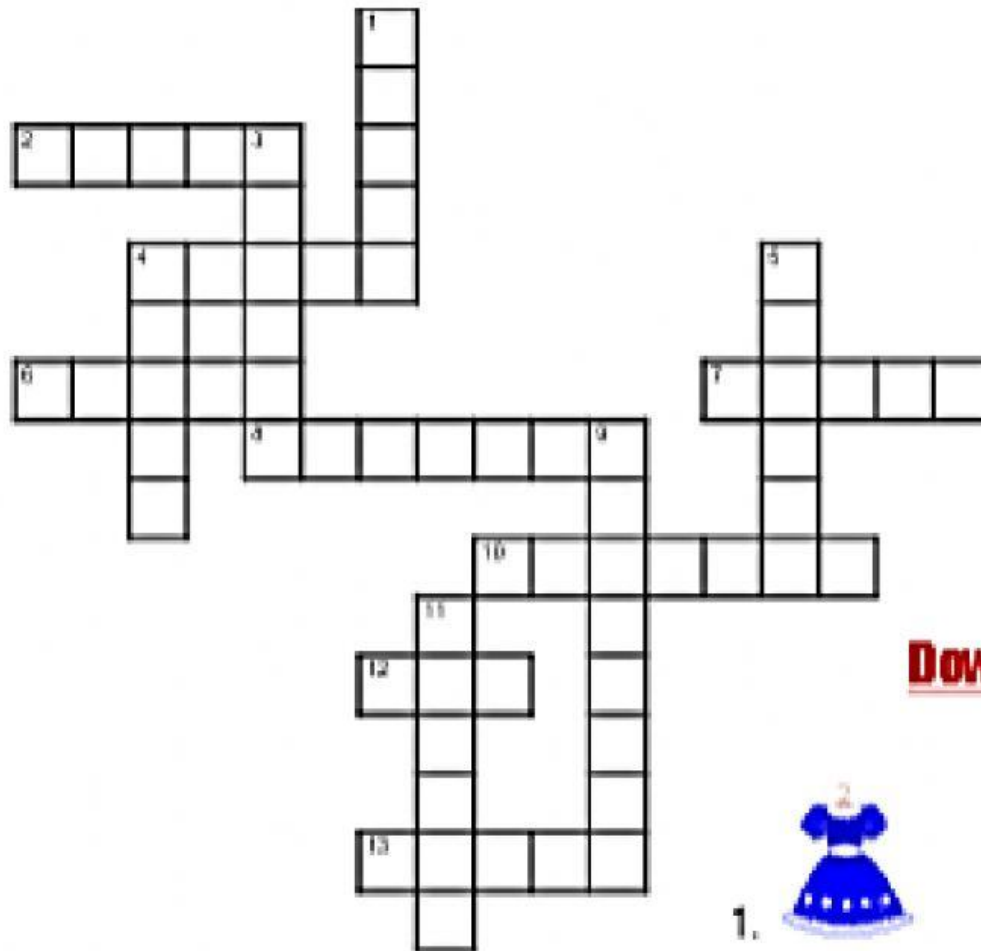

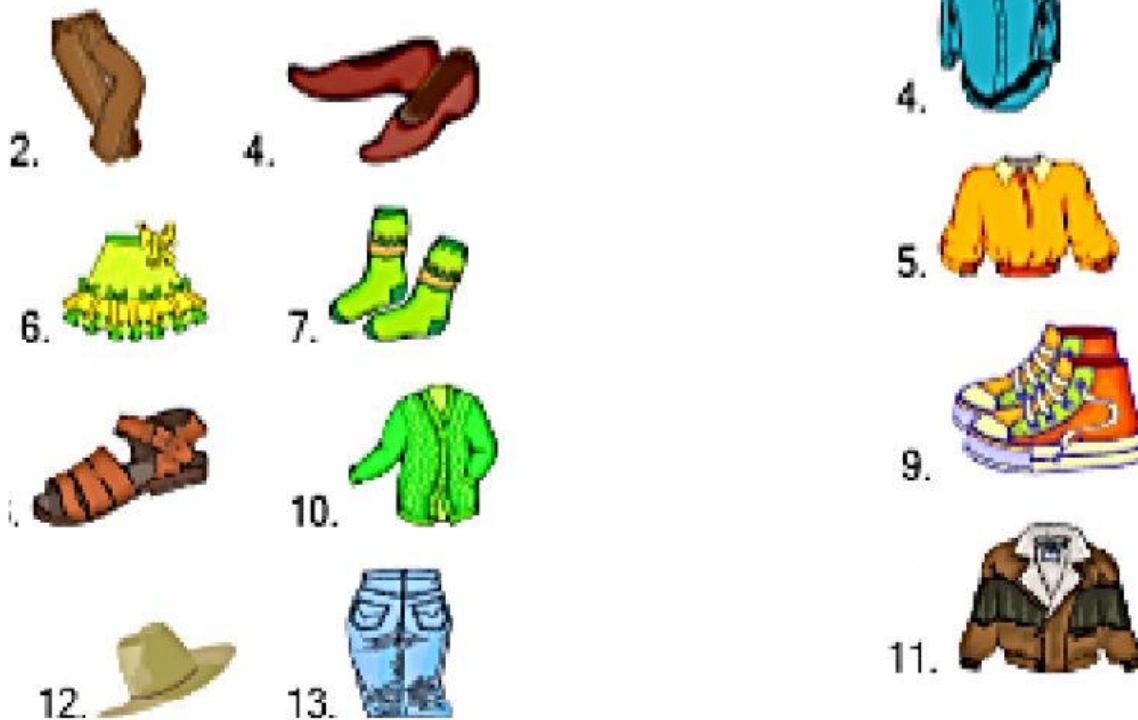
