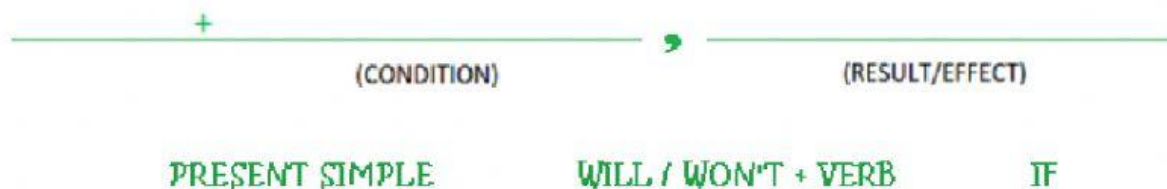

Drag and set up the correct structure of the First Conditional

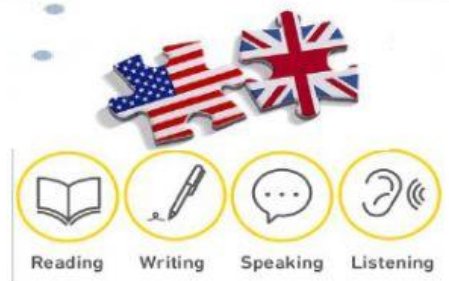
