

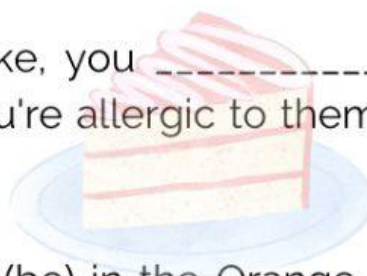
"Should have" or "supposed to" ?
