As any well-traveled person can tell you, hotels come in all shapes and sizes. Depending on a person's (1) _____, travelers can find a wide range of (2) _____ from huge resorts and spas to small roadside hotels. However, there are also (3) _____ types of hotels that are run by people from their own homes. These are called Bed and Breakfast Inns, or simply shortened to B&Bs.
