

A picnic story

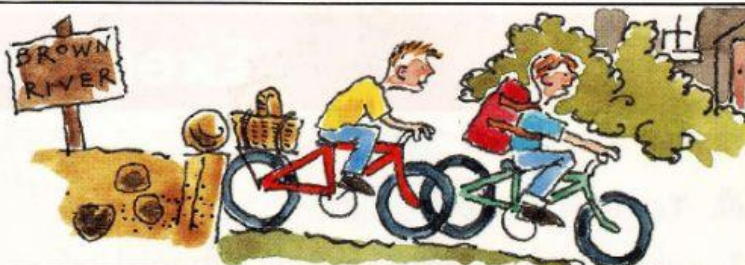

They are under a big tree near the river. The picnic basket is beside the tree. Alex is taking the towels from his bag. A cow is looking at Alex and Jack.



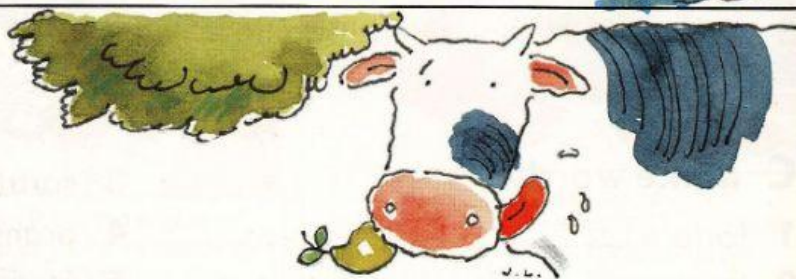

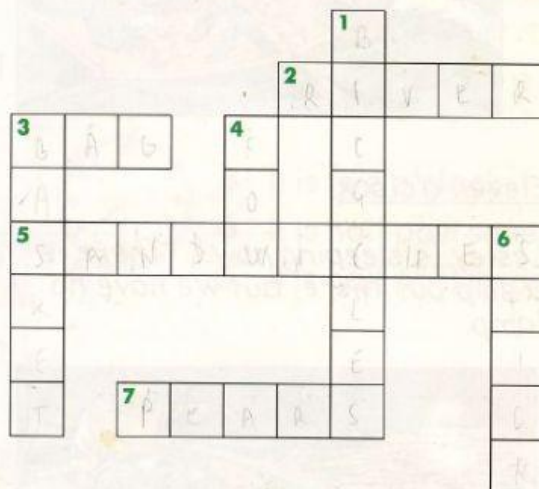
