

SECOND CONDITIONAL

We use the **SECOND CONDITIONAL** (If + Past simple, would + infinitive) to talk about imaginary situations in the present & future.

IF I HAD A BROTHER, I'D SHARE MY ROOM WITH HIM
(I Haven't gone a brother so I don't share my room)
