Cấu trúc	S + will + V-infinitive
Dấu hiệu nhận biết	tomorrow; next day / week / month / year; on + (ngày ở tương lai),...
Ví dụ	On Tuesday, Brian will have a dance party with friends. (<i>Thứ Ba này Brian sẽ có một buổi tiệc nhảy với bạn bè.</i>)

Cấu trúc	Shall I + V-infinitive ?

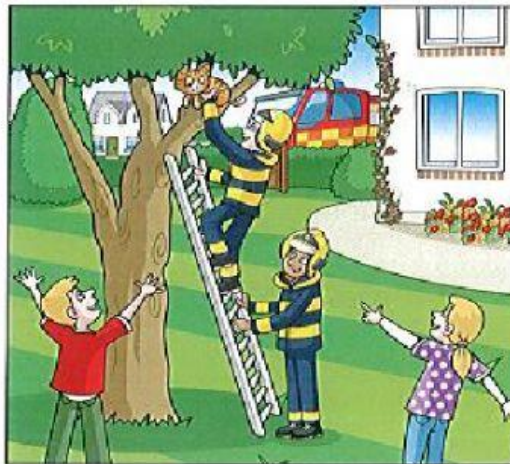
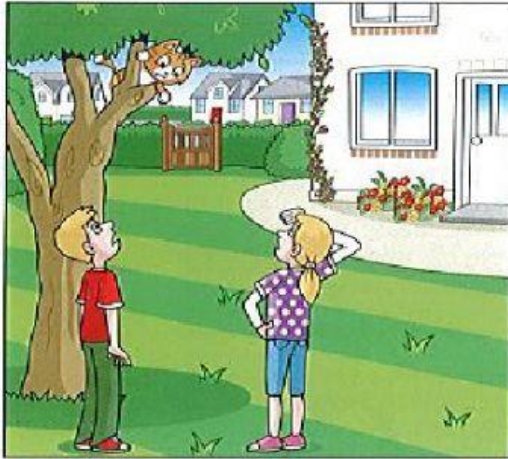
