(1)_____ Zeus defeated the Titans, Prometheus, the titan in control of foresight, and his brother, Epimetheus, were on the side of the Greek god. (2)_____ the two of them were titans, both of them considered Zeus as an ally and fought alongside him against their kin. (3)_____, a thankful Zeus provided them the task of creating all living things. (4)_____, they brought about not only life but also gifts that belonged to the living beings, allowing them to perform incredible feats and to be unique on their own.

(5)_____, Prometheus took special care when giving form to humans, allowing them to look like Greek gods. (6)_____, he could not grant them divinity because the gods thought of humans as worshipers and dependent of the gods' intervention. (7)_____ seeing the treatment his children received by the deities, he turned to the sacrifices that were meant to be made and tricked the Zeus and his kind by giving the meat to the humans and the remains to the gods.

Zeus found out the trickery that Prometheus played on him and forbade the use of fire for any purpose whatsoever. Prometheus, realizing his mistake, climbed up Mount Olympus and took the fire that belonged to the gods with him hidden in a fennel stalk. So, he brought the fire back to mankind, allowing them to seize control of the natural order.
