Write the name of each geometric shape according to its characteristic.

1. It is a polygon, which is formed by three sides and consists of three edges and three vertices. In addition, the sum of its internal angles is equal to 180o.

2. It has all angles equal to 60° and all sides of equal length.

3. It has 2 angles equal and 2 sides of equal length.

4. It has no angles equal, and no sides of equal length.

5. It has one right angle equal to 90°.

6. It has one obtuse angle (an angle greater than 90°). The other two angles are acute (less than 90°).



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7. It has a point in the centre from which each point on the diameter is equidistant. It has infinite lines of symmetry.

8. It has four sides which are equal to 90° each one.

9. It is like a circle that have been squashed or stretched.

10. It has two pairs of opposite sides equal in length and interior angles are at the right angles.

11. It is a quadrilateral with two pairs of parallel sides and opposite angles are equal in measure.

12. It has either 1 or 2 faces, 0 or 1 edges, and 1 apex .

13. It has either 2 or 3 faces, 0 or 2 edges, and 0 vertices.

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14. It has 6 faces, 12 edges, and 8 vertices. All sides are equal length. All faces are square in shape. It is a type of cuboid.

15. It has 6 faces, 12 edges and 8 vertices. All the faces are rectangular.

16. It has 0 or 1 faces, 0 edges and 0 vertices.

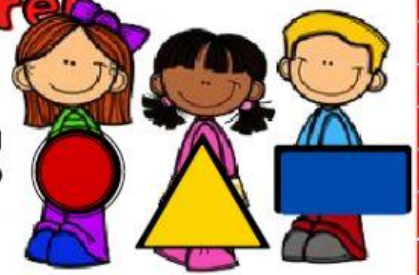
