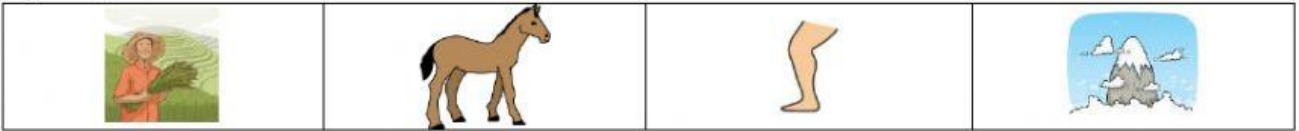
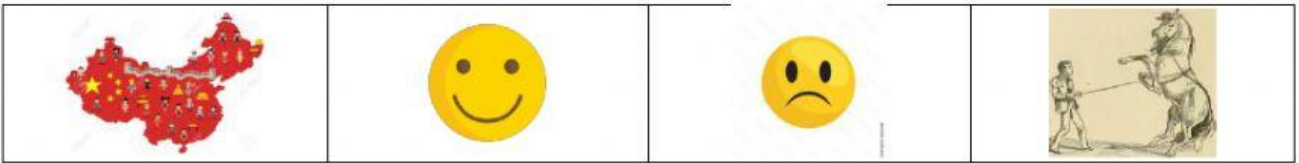


All Is Well
