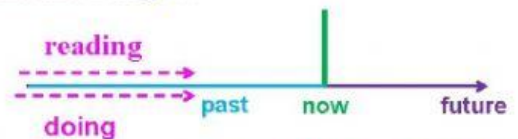
Long action = (watching TV),
