Passage 1

Malaysian artist Ibrahim Hussein's dream of a cultural oasis **housed** in a museum complex on an island paradise is slowly crystallizing. Recently, the Prime Minister Datuk Seri Mahathir Mohamad launched the arts museum which will be built on an 18-hectare site on Pulau Langkawi.

Ibrahim, or "Ib" to friends, has been moving mountains for the last two and a half years to bring about this development. He formed the Ibrahim Hussein Museum and Cultural Foundation to raise funds for this ambitious venture which is **estimated** to cost RM9 million.

The arts complex which is scheduled for completion in late 1994 will have eight galleries, studios, workshops, a library, a meeting room, a VIP lounge and a restaurant. It will house internationally **acclaimed** works of art, including some of Ibrahim's **pieces**.

In the context of Malaysia, which has yet to have an art museum of international standard, **Ibrahim's dream is indeed ambitious**. However, he has always broken new ground and taken on big challenges.

The son of a poor farmer, Ibrahim studied briefly at Singapore's Nanyang Academy of Arts in 1956. Later, he spent a short time at the Byam Shaw School of Drawing and Painting and at the Royal Academy of Arts in London. He was awarded a Fullbright travelling scholarship in 1967 and a Rocketfeller III Fund fellowship between 1967 and 1968.

Today, Ibrahim's paintings are the closest thing to a national art treasure. "When I paint, it's like a prayer, a gratitude, a joy," he says. When the art museum is built, Ibrahim will be sharing his message of joy with more people.
