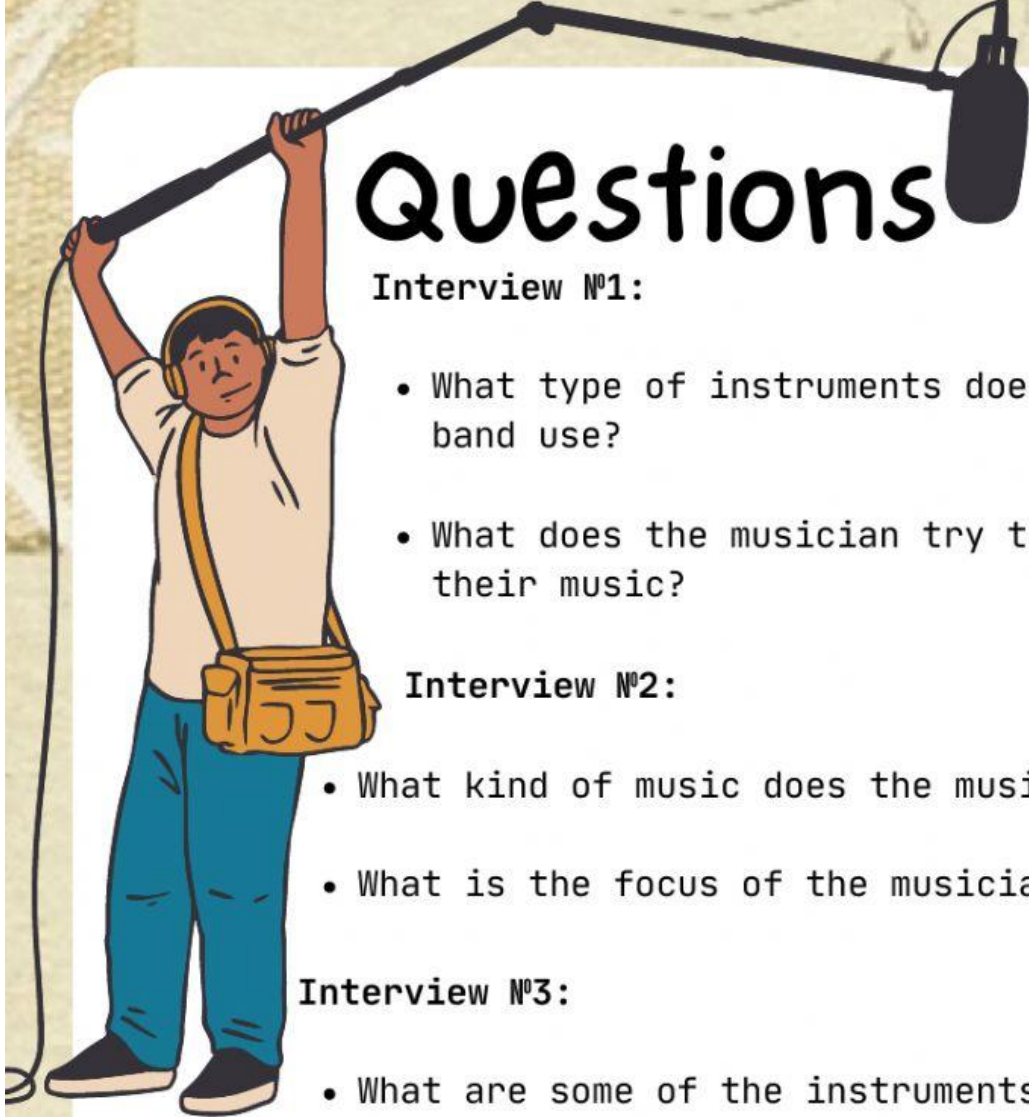
Interviewer: Can you tell us a bit about your music?
