Weekly and Occasional Fish Chores

Some people keep their pet fish in a fish bowl and others use an aquarium. Changing and cleaning the water in a fish bowl or aquarium need to be done weekly or when they get dirty.



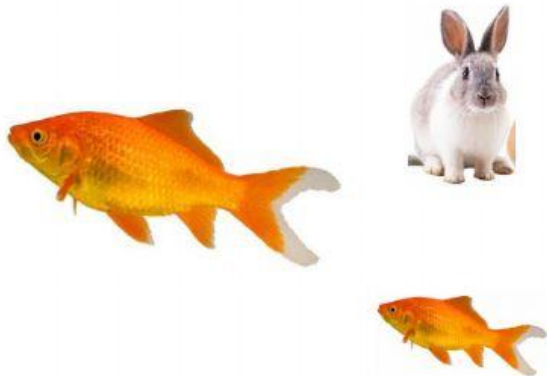
Changing the water in a fishbowl is a weekly pet chore. Water in a fishbowl gets dirty over the week because fish pee and poop in the fishbowl. It is important to give your pet fish clean water so it can be healthy



Changing the water in an aquarium is an occasional pet chore. Aquariums use a filtration system to keep the fish tank clean. The aquarium floor, walls and filter get dirty over time and need to be cleaned. It is important to clean the aquarium occasionally for your pet fish to stay healthy.
