Conditional sentences with can/can't have two parts:

If + Present Simple, we can + Verb

If it's raining, we can go shopping

We can change the order of the two parts, but we don't use a comma:

We can + Verb If + Present Simple

We can go shopping if it's raining

If it's	raining,	we can we can't	go shopping
	wet,		make a cake
	sunny,		have a picnic
	hot,		ride a mountain bike
	windy,		play table tennis
	dry,		watch TV
