Today England is governed directly by the Parliament of the United Kingdom, although other countries of the United Kingdom have devolved governments. England is part of the European Union but the English currency is the 11. _____ Sterling. England has many important celebrations for example, Guy Fawkes Night or Remembrance Day.
