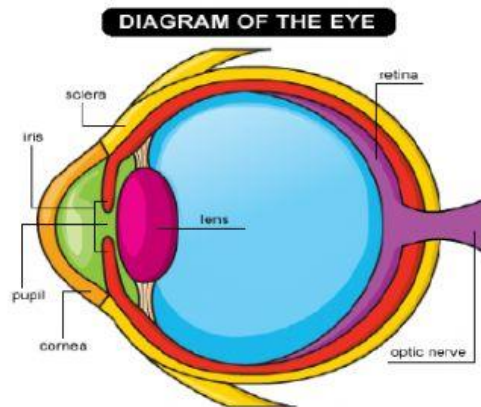




Drag and drop each part of the eye in the table below to its correct function. Use the diagram above to help you.
