

# The water cycle

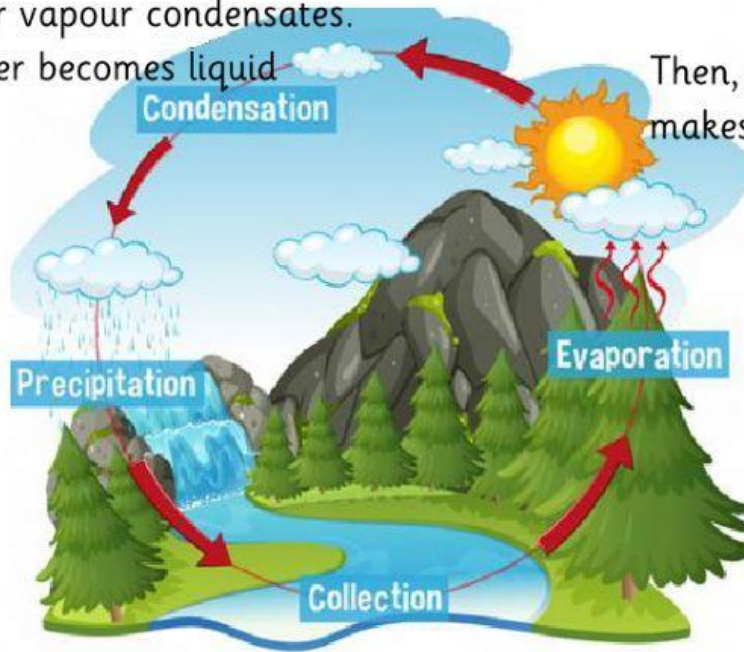
## 1. Read.

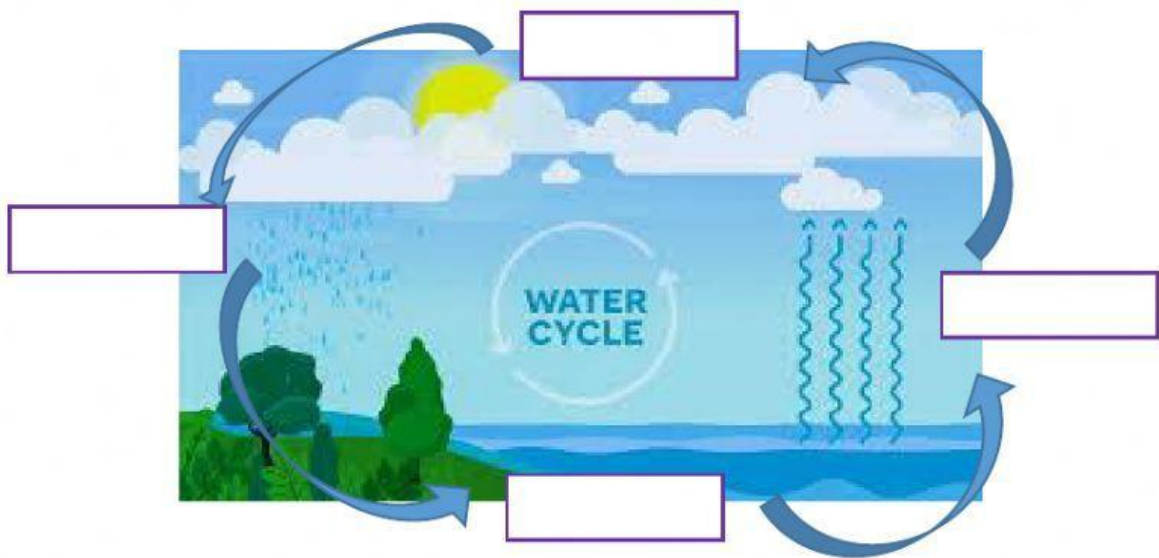
