Affirmative

I'm **going to** study.

You/We/They're **going to** study.

He/She/It's **going to** study.

Negative

I'm **not going to** study.

You/We/They **aren't going to** study.

He/She/It **isn't going to** study.

Questions

Am I **going to** study?

Are you/we/they **going to** study?

Is he/she/it **going to** study?

Short answers

Yes, I **am**. / No, I'm **not**.

Yes, you/we/they **are**. / No, you/we/they **aren't**.

Yes, he/she/it **is**. / No, he/she/it **isn't**.
