



● We use **-er** for short words (one syllable)

Large  larg**er**

hot → hotter

- We also use **-er** for two-syllable words that end in -y (**-y** → **ier**)

early $\rightarrow$ earlier

easy  easier

- We use **more** for longer words (**two syllables or more**)

nervous → **more** nervous

serious → **more** serious
