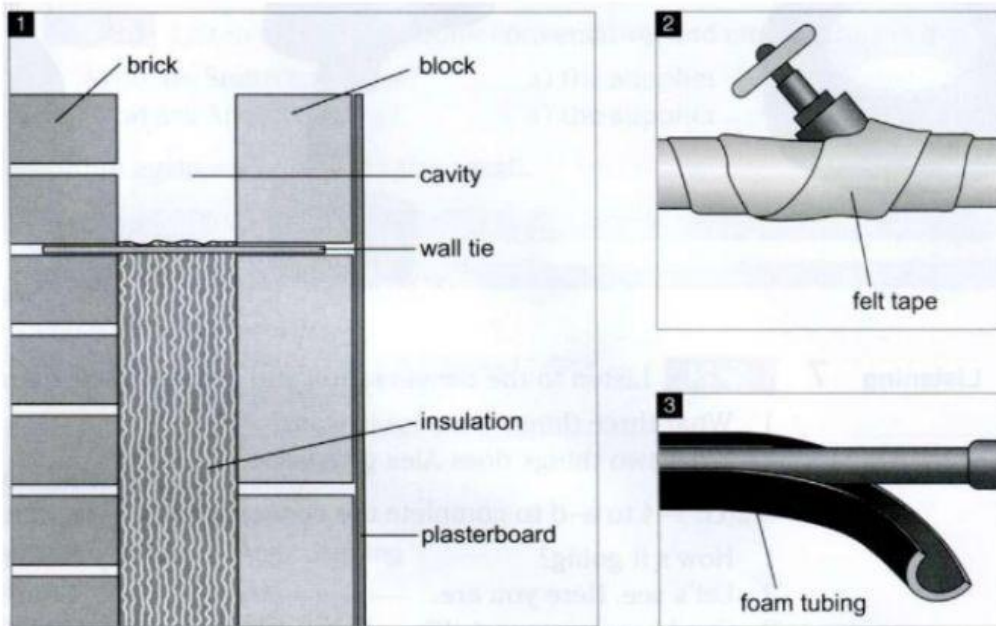

A: What's the difference?
B: Let me explain. Sometimes walls are solid, so the insulation is on the outside of the wall. This is solid wall insulation.

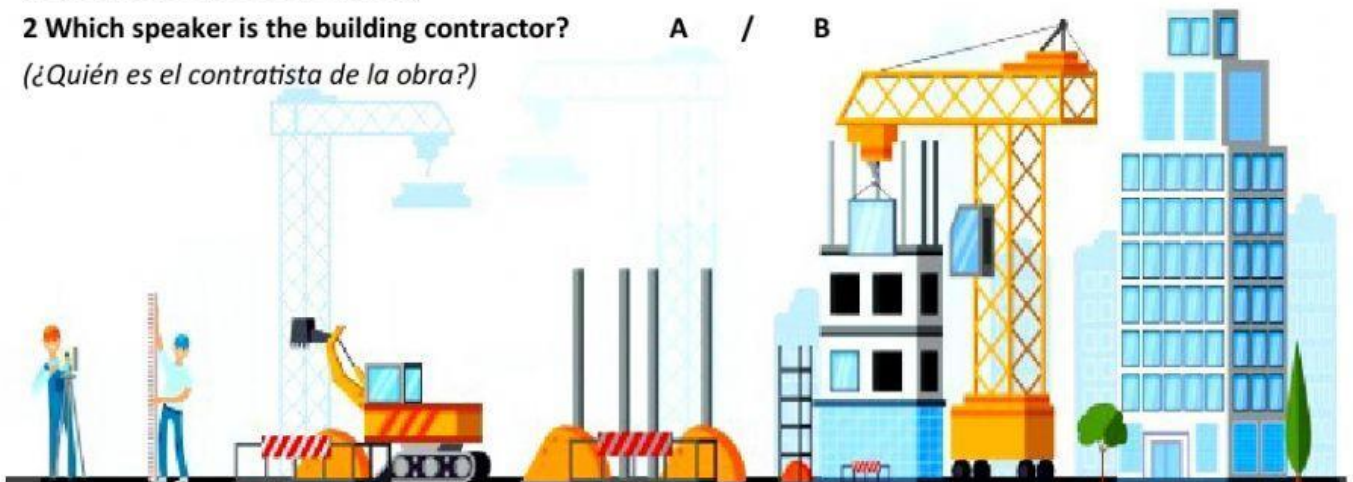

ACTIVITY 2: Before we continue with the dialogue, study this chart. (*Antes de continuar con el diálogo, estudiá esta tabla*)

Used to/Used as/Used for	
Used to is followed by a verb.	Solid wall insulation is used to provide thermal insulation.
Used as/used for is followed by a noun or adjective + noun.	Polystyrene beads are used as cavity wall insulation. Felt tape is used for pipes.

Used to (*se usa para, usado/a para*) como se observa en el ejemplo, después de esta frase necesitamos un verbo (*to + verbo*): Solid wall insulation is **used to provide** thermal insulation (*El aislamiento de pared sólida se usa para proporcionar aislamiento térmico*)

Used as (*se usa como, usado/a como*) se utiliza seguido de un sustantivo o de un adjetivo + sustantivo. Polystyrene beads are **used as** cavity wall insulation (*Las esferas de poliestireno se usan como aislamiento en paredes huecas*)

Used for (*se usa para, usado para*) al igual que el anterior, se utiliza seguido de un sustantivo o de un adjetivo + sustantivo. Felt tape is **used for** pipes (*La cinta adhesiva de fieltro se usa para tuberías*)

En resumen:

Used to + verb (*Used to + verbo*)

Used as / Used for + noun or adjective + noun (*Used as / used for + sustantivo / adjetivo + sustantivo*)
