Sydney Y. – We will have robots that clean up after us.

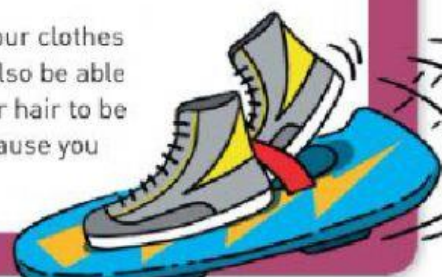
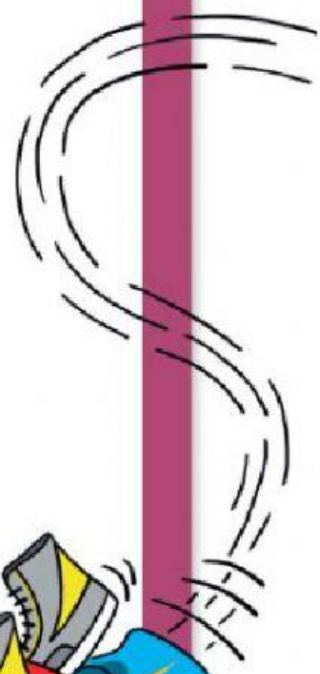
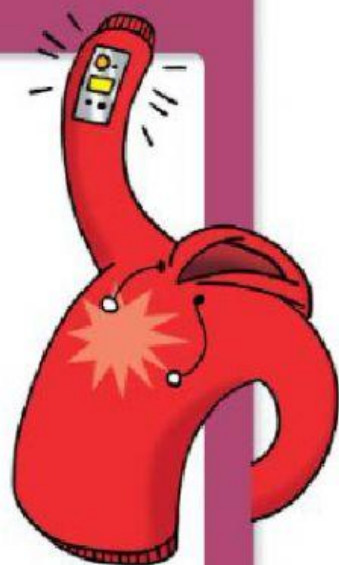
- 10 The X-box game will be so small it will fit in your watch. Time machines will be amazing.
