The steam engine (la máquina de vapor)

The steam engine was one of the most important inventions of the Industrial Revolution. Steam engines were used in factories, mines, locomotives, and steamboats.

Who invented the steam engine?

The first useful steam engine was invented by Thomas Newcomen in 1712, but James Watt in 1765 improved the first one and it was more useful.

The telegraph (el telégrafo)

The **telegraph** is a device for communicating over a distance. It uses electricity to send coded messages through wires. In the middle of the 1800s the **telegraph** was the fastest way to communicate over long distances.

Who invented the telegraph?

Samuel Morse was the first person to make a telegraph using only one wire. In 1844, he built a telegraph line that went from Baltimore to Washington, D.C.

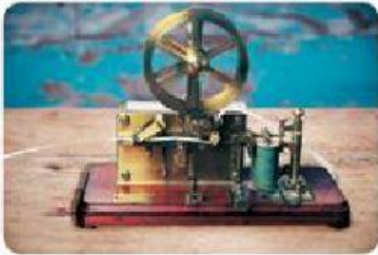
