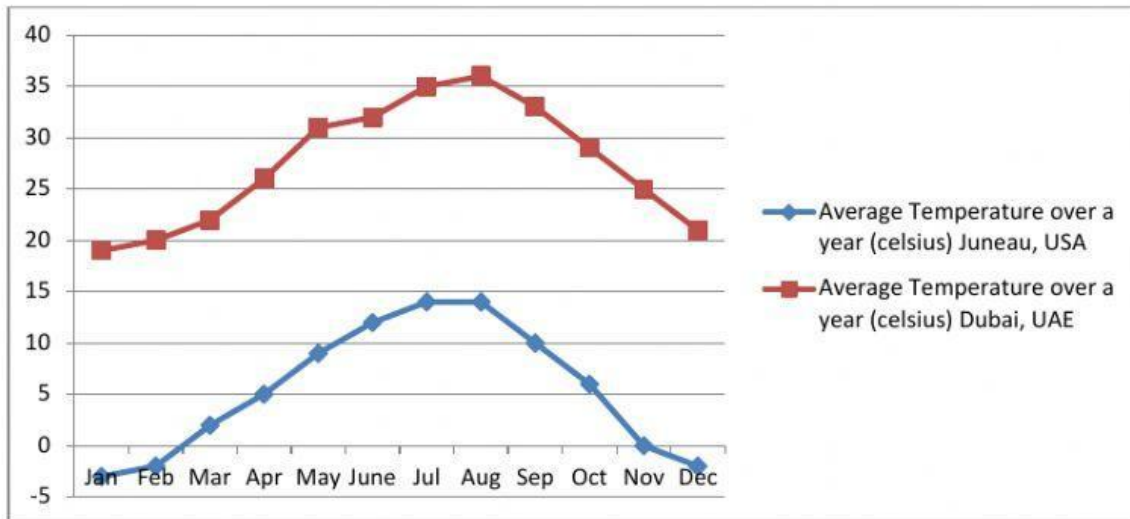


A line graph is used to display information which changes over time. It is plotted on a graph as a series of points joined with straight lines.

Look at this average yearly temperature graph for two cities. It shows the temperatures in $^{\circ}\text{C}$ for each city, every month of the year



Your task: Use the line graph to answer the questions below.

Which city had the highest temperature?	
What was it? When did it occur?	
Which city had the lowest temperature?	
What was it? When did it occur?	
What is the difference between the temperature in Juneau and the temperature in Dubai in August?	

Reasoning: Which city has the biggest difference in temperature over the course of a year?
Explain how you know this.
