Ve use going to:
- To talk about (4)for the future that haven't been arranged or agreed ye
Ex: I'm going to visit my friend in Turkey sometime next year.
- To talk about things we expect to happen because of (5)
Ex: It's going to rain soon. (There are big grey clouds)
Ve use the present continuous:
- For (6) These are activities that we've agreed to do with other people. \
know the details such as when, where, etc.
Ex: I'm playing in a football match on Saturday.
Ve use the present simple:
- For (7)

Ex: The film finishes at 9:30 p.m.
