Get to the bottom of it



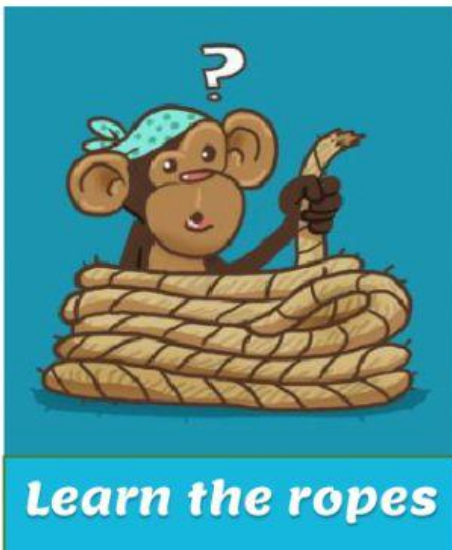


Face to face
