

- A- MANUEL JOSÉ JOAQUÍN DEL CORAZÓN DE JESÚS BELGRANO WAS BORN IN ..... ON 3RD JUNE, 1770.
- B- A SMALL BOY, A BIG .....
- C- MANUEL BELGRANO WAS A LAWYER, ....., JOURNALIST, POLITICIAN, MILITARY OFFICER AND A GREAT BELIEVER IN EDUCATION.
- D- IN 1793 HE GRADUATED FROM ..... IN SPAIN.
- E- IN BUENOS AIRES, HE WAS .....
- F- HE CREATED THE NAUTICAL SCHOOL, THE COMMERCE SCHOOL, AND THE GEOMETRICAL AND ..... ACADEMY.
- G- IN 1801 HE TOOK PART IN THE PUBLICATION OF THE FIRST NEWSPAPER OF BUENOS AIRES, THE .....
- H- IN 1810 HE PARTICIPATED IN THE ..... AND HE WAS ELECTED A MEMBER OF THE FIRST LOCAL GOVERNMENT.
- I- BELGRANO WAS APPOINTED GENERAL AND HE WAS SENT ON MANY ..... EXPEDITIONS TO MONTEVIDEO, ROSARIO, TUCUMÁN, JUJUY Y SALTA.
- J- IT WAS IN ROSARIO, IN 1812 WHERE BELGRANO CREATED AND RAISED THE ..... FOR THE FIRST TIME.
- K- IN 1816, BELGRANO WORKED FOR THE .....
- BELGRANO, LIKE MANY OTHER NATIONAL HEROES IN HISTORY, DEVOTED HIS LIFE TO FIGHTING FOR INDEPENDENCE. ON 20TH JUNE, 1820, HE DIED VERY ILL, AT THE AGE OF 50.**
