Complete with was, were, weren't and wasn't:

Yesterday, it (be) raining and thundering all day. Ann (be) playing inside the house. She wanted to be outside. She (be not) playing outside because it was raining. She (be) feeling tired of being trapped inside the house.

Ann (be) trying to keep busy inside the house. She (be) reading her book until the electricity went out. Then, she decided to practice her sewing. She (be) practicing sewing until lunchtime. After lunch, she sat by the window and watched the rain.

While Ann (be) watching the rain, the phone rang. Her mother (be) calling to say she (be) coming home. She (be) bringing a new game. Ann and her mother ate ice cream and played the game.

While they (be) playing, the rain stopped! But Ann didn't even notice. She (be) having such a good time with her mom!

Why wasn't she playing outside her house?

How did she feel being trapped at home by the rain?

What did she practice until lunchtime?

What happened while she saw the rain?
