

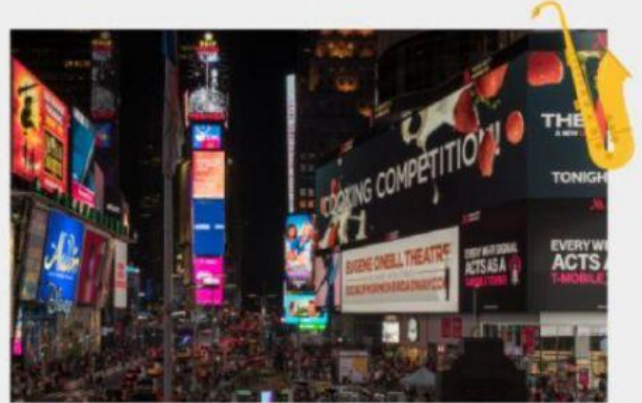


New York City
