OBJECT / IDEA / ACTION



Normally asks about things.

Example: What were you doing?



PLACE



Asks about place?

Example: Where was Ana living?



REASON



Asks about reason.

Example: Why was he crying?



PERSON



Asks about the subject (person)

Example: Who was singing?



TIME



Asks about time.

Example: When were they working?



MANNER



Asks in what way

Example: how were you traveling?
