What are adverbs of frequency?



Adverbs of frequency are used to discuss **how** **often** something happens. They are used to show routines or activities that are repeated.

Basic rules:

	George is seldom late for school. My uncle is sometimes silly and funny. Answer "A" is not always correct.
	Amy rarely goes to school by bus. I sometimes go shopping at Metrotown. Tom hardly left his book on the bus.
	His book is hardly left on the bus. Jim and Helen have never been to China. The adverbs of frequency are often used with the present tense.
