General Tips

1. Start your letter by explaining why you haven't written for a long time.
2. When writing an informal letter, use the contractions: *don't, doesn't, didn't, I'm* etc.
3. Remember to ask questions to speak directly to a reader: *Guess what? / What do you think?* etc.
4. Always use linkers: *Firstly, secondly, thirdly.../In my opinion.../On the one hand, on the other hand* etc.
5. Always divide your letter into paragraphs: an introductory one, 3 main paragraphs and a conclusion.
6. Remember that you're writing to a FRIEND and a friend is someone whom you know well! Give details that show it.
7. Always give a reason for ending your letter. It shows that you're polite.
8. Sign off with a friendly phrase: *Hugs, Take care, All the best, Hang in there* etc.
9. Don't write any surnames, addresses or dates when writing an informal letter.
