

# VERB TENSES

## Present Simple\* FORMATION



### Positive Form

I/you/we/they + verb  
he/she/it + verb + s/es

### Positive Example

They live there.

### Negative Form

I/you/we/they + do not + verb  
he/she/it + does not + verb

### Negative Example

They don't live there

### Question Form











Do + I/you/we/they + verb ?  
Does + he/she/it + verb ?

### Question Example

Do they live there?

\* This tense is also known as simple present.

→ Phrase affirmative 

base verbale (= infinitif)


complément

Sujet

→ Phrase négative 

complément

base verbale

not

Sujet

do / does

**does** à la 3<sup>ème</sup> personne du singulier.

Formes contractées :

do not = don't

does not = doesn't
