

Now dear student let's study the rules included in this unit:

و الآن عزيزي الطالب دعنا ندرس معاً القواعد الواردة في هذه الوحدة

love / would love / would prefer

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- 1 (We) love means 'always really like'. = نحب دائما
 - 2 (I) would love means 'really want now'. أريد الآن وفي التو.
 - 3 Would you like means 'Please have'.
 - 4 When we accept an offer, we can say this more politely with 'Yes, please.'
عندما أقبل عرض مقدم فإننا أقبل بأدب و أقول **Yes, please..**
 - 5 When we do not accept an offer, we can say this more politely with 'Thank you, but...'
عندما لا أقبل عرض مقدم لي فإني أرفض بأدب و أقول **"Thank you , but"**
 - 6 We use would like + infinitive to mean 'want' to do something.
نستخدم **would like +infinitive** للدلالة على الرغبة في عمل شيء ما الآن
 - 7 We use would prefer + infinitive to mean 'want' to do something else.
نستخدم **would prefer +infinitive** للدلالة على الرغبة في عمل شيء آخر غير المعروض علي.
- I love sweets. أنا أحب الحلويات
- I would love sweets. أنا أحب أن أتناول الحلويات الآن
- Would you like a cake? تفضل تناول الكعك؟

هام هام هام يتبع **would like / would love / would prefer** ← المصدر = الفعل مجرد + to

يتبع **love / like** المصدر أو الفعل + ing و المعنى لا يختلف في الحالتين.

I love to eat sweets = I love eating sweets

in order to + infinitive

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We can show the purpose of an action with **to + infinitive** or **in order to + infinitive**.

نستخدم المصدر **to** أو **in order to** + المصدر للتعبير عن الهدف أو الغاية.

- I go to school **to learn** = I go to school **in order to learn**.
- They wear the same dresses **to stop** bad spirits.
= they wear the same dresses **in order to** stop bad spirits

We can use in order to instead of so as follows:

نستخدم **in order to** بدلاً من **so** كما يلي :

I wanted to watch the film ,**so** I **went to the cinema**.



I went to the cinema **to** watch the film .

نحذف **so** ونبدأ بالجملة الثانية (التي تلي **so**) ونحذف الفاعل و الفعل (**want**) في الجملة الأولى و نكمل الجملة بالمصدر مع **to**.
