REGULAR VERBS

- +  + verb (ed/e)
-  + didn't + verb
- ? (Wh) Did +  + verb + ?
-  = Subject

IRREGULAR VERBS

- +  + verb in past
-  + didn't + inf. verb
- ? (Wh) Did +  + inf. verb + ?
-  = Subject

ADVERBS

- Yesterday
- Last week
- Last month, etc.
- Recently
- 2 days ago/weeks ago/ years ago
- For 2 weeks/months.
- In April
- In 2002
