Words that end with hissing sounds
s, x, sh add es to be plural.

If the word ends consonant y don't stress. Change y to  add es.

F or Fe

Drop the F and drop the fes.

Add ves to make it easy.

Don't drop the f if it is double

. Don't let the exceptions give you
trouble.

CH ,Z

If the word ends in "ch" or "z",

Just add es to make it easy.
