WEB PAGE INFORMATION ABOUT COVID 19

Home	What is the COVID-19 virus? COVID-19 is an infectious disease caused by a recently discovered type of coronavirus.
Triage (test yourself)	How does COVID-19 spread? People can catch COVID-19 from a person who has the virus (when the person coughs or exhales) or by touching surfaces that have been infected and then touching their eyes, nose or mouth.
Help (talk to a doctor)	How can I protect myself from catching COVID-19? <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Wash your hands regularly.• Maintain distance from other people.• Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.• Cover your mouth with your elbow or a tissue when you sneeze or cough.• Stay at home
Publications	When should I wear an approved COVID-19 mask? You should wear an approved COVID-19 mask especially when you have the COVID-19 symptoms.
Questions and answers (Q&A)	What is the source of COVID-19? It is possible that the source of COVID-19 be an animal, but this is not confirmed.
About us	When was the virus that causes COVID-19 discovered? This is a new variety of coronavirus discovered in a laboratory in Wuhan, China, in December 2019.
	Who does COVID-19 affect the most? Older people or people with a pre-existing medical condition (heart disease, cancer, etc.) appear to be more at risk than children or young adults. About one in every five people who catch COVID-19 need hospital care.

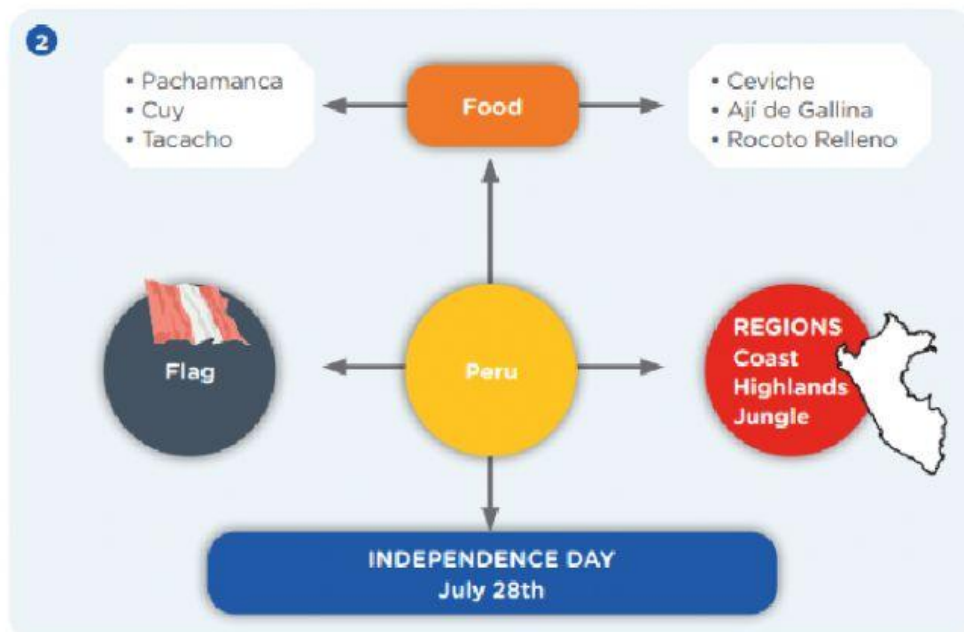
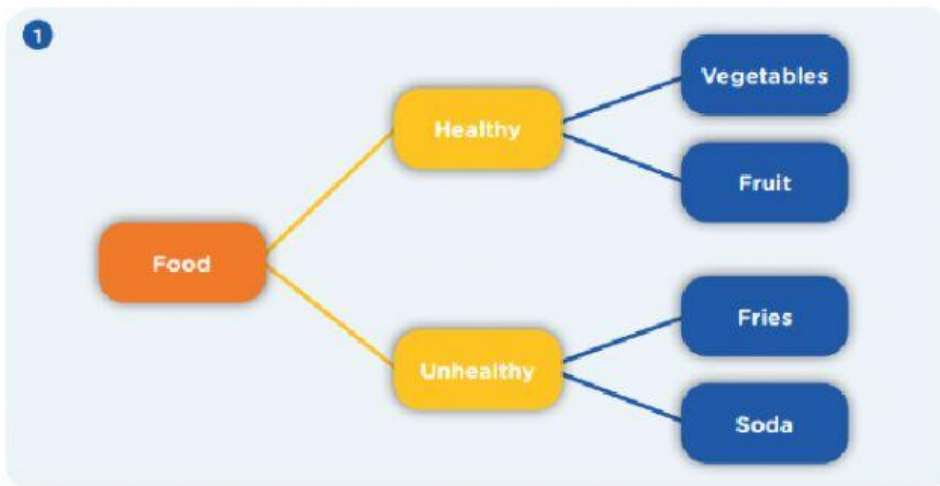
