Hindu wedding

In Hindu culture, weddings symbolize a union between families rather than a mere link between a man and a woman. Ceremonial rituals will begin the moment the bride's parents choose a husband for their daughter. Then the bride and groom and their families visit the priest together, known as Brahman, who must give the go-ahead to the wedding, and choose the date and time of the wedding based on the position of the stars. The importance of family union is symbolized again in a curious ritual called Barat, which occurs the day before the wedding, and in which the groom together with his family and friends performs a procession on horseback to his future wife's house, demonstrating the respect and union that will exist between both families.
