## Lesson 5 Present perfect affirmative and negative

Affirmative		
I / You / We / They	've (have)	watered the plants.
He / She	's (has)	

Negative		
I / You We / They	haven't (have not)	watered the plants.
He / She	hasn't (has not)	

### Write the sentences.

1 She / sweep the patio ✗

*She hasn't swept the patio.*

2 You / cut the grass ✓

3 We / wash the car ✓

4 He / hang out the clothes ✗

5 They / eat dinner yet ✗

### Look!

Remember, we make the past participle of regular verbs by adding *ed* (or *d*) to the end.

wash → washed

breathe → breathed

The past participles of irregular verbs with don't follow a pattern.

hang → hung do → done
