1. There are 37 children in the classroom, each student will get 34 pencils. How many pencils will the teacher have to give out ?

2. There are 17 calories in a candy bar. How many calories are there in 29 candy bars ?

3. Joan has saved 30 quarters from washing cars. How many cents does Joan have ? (1 Quarters = 25 cents)
