I believe I **AM GOING TO GET / WILL GET** an assignment next week.

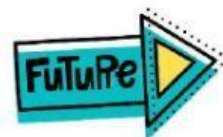
Following my plans, I **AM GOING TO JOIN / WILL JOIN** the designing department tomorrow.
